SUBJECT: Welcome to the 2025/2026 Academic Session: Resumption and Campus Regulations

On behalf of the Student Affairs Division, it is my great pleasure to welcome both our freshers and returning students to the 2025/2026 Academic Session. We hope you had a restful break.

Hostel Opening Date:

The hostel will officially open on Sunday, 11th January 2026. All halls of residence will be open for occupancy starting at **8:00 AM on Sunday, 11th January 2026.**

As we begin this new session, our primary goal is to maintain a safe, conducive, and disciplined environment for learning. To ensure the well-being of all residents, we wish to remind you that the following university regulations are in full effect and carry strict penalties for violations:

1. Hygiene and Environmental Sanitation

- **Prohibition of Open Defecation:** Open defecation is strictly forbidden. Students must use the designated restroom facilities provided in the hostels and academic areas.
- **Waste Management:** Littering is not tolerated. All waste must be disposed of in the provided bins. A clean environment is essential to preventing outbreaks of disease.
- **Water Usage:** "Splitting" or splashing water in hallways, common areas, or balconies is prohibited to prevent slipping hazards and structural damage to the buildings.

2. Electrical Appliances and Fire Safety

- **Banned Items:** To prevent fire outbreaks and electrical overloads, the use of heavy-duty appliances; including **hot plates, electric cookers, immersion heaters, and refrigerators** is strictly forbidden in the hostels.
- **Cooking:** Cooking is only permitted in designated kitchenette areas using approved methods (e.g., gas cylinders stored in designated cages, where applicable).

3. Security and Personal Property

- **High-Value Gadgets:** While we acknowledge the need for technology, students are strongly discouraged from the ostentatious display of exceptionally expensive handsets or jewelry. The university will not be held liable for the loss of high-value items kept in common rooms.

- **ID Cards:** For security purposes, all students must carry their University ID cards at all times and present them upon request by security personnel.

4. Code of Conduct and Residency

- **Squatting:** The act of "squatting" (harboring unregistered occupants) is a serious offense. Both the legal occupant and the squatter will face immediate disciplinary action and potential loss of accommodation.
- **Curfew and Quiet Hours:** Students are expected to be within the hostel premises and off-campus accommodation by **10:00 PM and 12:00 PM** respectively. Noise levels must be kept to a minimum to respect the rights of others to study and sleep.
- **Dress Code:** Please adhere to the University's approved dress code at all times within the campus premises.

The University Management is committed to your success and comfort. However, we require your full cooperation to keep our facilities functional. Failure to comply with the above directives will result in the immediate forfeiture of hostel bed spaces and further disciplinary measures.
