Eligible candidates should log onto the University website: [www.adsu.edu.ng](http://www.adsu.edu.ng) click on post UTME and fill in the necessary information.

Candidates who did not choose Adamawa State University, Mubi and are willing to change, are advised to log onto JAMB website and effect their first choice of institution to Adamawa State University, Mubi.

**THE SCREENING PROCEDURE**

- a. The screening exercise will commence from Monday 15<sup>th</sup> June to 30<sup>th</sup> October, 2026.
- b. The Screening fee is two thousand (N2, 000) Naira only.
- c. The Method of Payment is Online
- d. Candidate are to scan and upload relevant documents such as;
  - i. Jamb result/DE slip
  - ii. 'O' Level/'A' level results
  - iii. Candidates awaiting their 'O' Level result should indicate.
  - iv. Candidates are advised to use their JAMB registration number as their user name and surname as password (As reflected on the UTME/DE registration slip).
