**PRE-DEGREE AND JUPEB ADMISSIONS  
 FOR 2025/2026 ACADEMIC SESSION**

**T**he Centre for Foundation Programme (CFFP) has commenced admissions into Pre-Degree and JUPEB Programmes of Ekiti State University, Ado-Ekiti (EKSU) for the 2025/2026 Academic Session. Applicants without UTME qualifications seeking admission into the University can explore the available opportunities as follows:

- a. one-year Pre-Degree education for entry into 100 Level in the University or
- b. one-year JUPEB Programme for entry into 200 level in the University.

**Key Features of admissions into the Pre-Degree and JUPEB Programmes:**

**Purpose and Duration:** The Centre prepares candidates for admission into undergraduate classes after completing Pre-Degree or JUPEB programmes and passing the required examinations with JAMB registration.

**Entry Requirements and Available Courses:** Candidates must possess a minimum of five (5) credit passes in SSCE/GCE Ordinary Level (in not more than two (2) sittings) for admission. The programme offers opportunity for admission into a wide range of disciplines in the Faculties such as: Faculty of Agricultural Sciences: (Agricultural Economics and Extension Service; Animal Production and Health Sciences; Crop, Horticulture and Landscape Design, Soil Resources and Environmental Management, Forestry Resources and Wildlife, and Fisheries and Aquaculture) Faculty of Arts (English, French, History and International Studies, Linguistics and Nigerian Languages, Philosophy, Religious Studies, Yoruba, Theatre and Media Arts); Faculty of Education; Faculty of Law: Law (based on quota and passes); Faculty of Management Sciences: (Accounting, Actuarial Science, Business Administration, Entrepreneurship Studies, Finance, Industrial Relations and Personnel Management, Insurance, Cooperative Studies, Marketing); Faculty of Science: (Biochemistry, Chemistry, Computer Science, Geology, Geophysics, Industrial Chemistry, Microbiology, Plant Science and Biotechnology, Physics, Mathematics, Statistics, Zoology and Science Laboratory Technology); Faculty of the Social Sciences: (Economics, Geography and Planning Science, Tourism Studies, Environmental Management, Political Science, Sociology, Psychology); Faculty of Multidisciplinary Studies: (Gender Studies, Peace and Conflict Studies); College of Medicine: (Anatomy, Physiology, Nursing Science, Medicine & Surgery (based on quota and passes)).

**Benefits and Learning Environment:** Students are admitted into their levels and chosen degree programmes upon successful completion of the academic session, provided they obtained JAMB. Students will access lecture rooms, hostel accommodation, library facilities, and participate in community service during the period of study; taught by experienced Academic Staff. All successful candidates in the Pre-Degree and JUPEB Programmes will be admitted into the regular programmes upon meeting admission requirements.

**ADMISSIONS INTO DIPLOMA PROGRAMMES  
 FOR 2025/2026 ACADEMIC SESSION**

**T**he Centre for Foundation Programmes (CFFP) has commenced admissions into Diploma and Advanced Diploma Programmes of Ekiti State University, Ado-Ekiti (EKSU) for the 2025/2026 Academic Session. Applicants with minimum of four (4) Credit passes in SSCE/GCE Ordinary Level (in not more than two (2) sittings) are eligible to apply for admission into the programmes.

**Key Features of admissions into the Diploma Programmes:**

**Purpose and Duration:** Diploma and Advanced Diploma programmes run for two (2) Academic Sessions each and are designed for these categories of applicants:

- a. school Leavers who are unable to commence Degree Programme, but wish to upscale their knowledge with educational certification by obtaining Diploma as additional qualifications and those who cannot undergo Regular/ Part-Time Degree, but are desirous of obtaining Diploma through work and study for educational purposes, further studies and academic certification;
- b. matured candidates with or without working experience with minimum of High School certificate desirous of obtaining academic and professional certifications at Diploma level (special consideration may be given to mature candidates with relevant working experience, even with fewer qualifications); and
- c. degree holders in different academic/professional calling wishing to possess additional academic qualifications and educational training in other relevant fields at Diploma level.

**Benefits and Learning Environment:**

Students admitted into the programmes can use their certificate to pursue Bachelor's degree as direct entry candidate on JAMB enrolment. Students will access lecture rooms, library facilities, and participate in community service during the period of study.

**Entry Requirements:**

Candidates must possess a minimum of four (4) credit passes in SSCE, GCE, NECO, NABTEB, or their equivalent in relevant courses (in not more than two (2) sittings) for admission into the Diploma Programme and a Diploma/Certificate/Degree for Advanced Diploma.

**Available Courses:** The programme offers admission into the following disciplines: **Agricultural Economics & Extension Service; Animal Production & Health Sciences; Crop & Environmental Science, Fisheries & Aquaculture, Forest Resources and Wildlife, Accountancy, Business Administration, Banking and Finance, Computer Science, Sociology (Criminology & Penology), Economics, Educational Management, Estate Management, Human Resources Management, Marketing, Mass Communication, Public Administration, Psychology, Public & International Relations, Purchasing and Supply Management, Security Operations, Science and Laboratory Technology (SLT), Transportation Management, Geography and Planning Science, Tourism and Hospitality Management, Environmental Management, Local and Urban Government, Political Science, Law, Crime and Prevention Control, Gender and Health Studies, Faculty of Law: Diploma in Law, College of Medicine: Diploma in Mortuary Services.**
